[←Back](#)**22 November, 2006****GEO FOREIGN MINISTER VISITS KINGDOM OF NORWAY**

On November 20-21, 2006 Minister of Foreign Affairs of Georgia Gela Bezhushvili paid an official visit to the Kingdom of Norway, Georgian Foreign Ministry reported.

On November 21, the Head of the Georgian Foreign Office met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Norway Jonas Gahr Støre and Minister of Justice and the Police of the Kingdom of Norway Knut Storberget.

"The meetings focused on prospects of bilateral cooperation between Georgia and Norway, ongoing reforms and process of democratic development in our country, the Peace Plans for resolution of the conflicts on the territory of Georgia, Georgian-Russian relations and Georgia's integration into NATO and cooperation with the European Union," the statement reads.

According to the ministry, during the talks, "the Norwegian side expressed its full support and pledged to help Georgia to integrate into the European and Euro-Atlantic structures as well as showed its interest and readiness to expand bilateral cooperation in the fields of economy and energy and to popularize Georgian wines in the market of Norway."

The Georgian Foreign Minister with a view to attracting foreign investments to Georgia held a meeting with representatives of Norwegian business circles.

Mr. Bezhushvili took part in the presentation of Georgian Wine organized by the EU-Georgia Business Council (EUGBC). While addressing the audience at the Nobel Institute the Foreign Minister updated the representatives of the political and scientific circles on the positions and approaches of the Georgian Authorities towards all topical issues of international relations.
